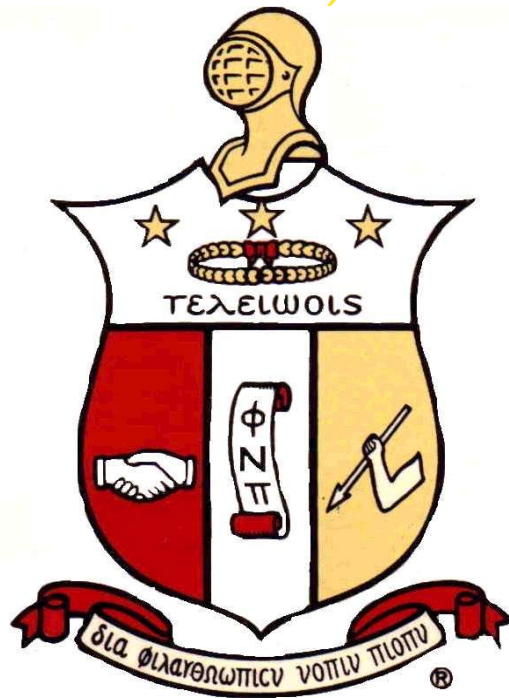

PURPOSE

The Kappa Instructional Leadership League, also known as “Kappa League,” sponsored by Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. is an organization oriented toward helping young men of high school and middle school age to grow and develop their leadership talents in every phase of human endeavor. It provides both challenging and rewarding experiences which richly enhance their lives. Since the fundamental purpose of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. is achievement, it is therefore, the fraternity’s primary purpose to help these young men achieve worthy goals for themselves and to make constructive contributions to their community when leadership roles become their responsibility.



This will be achieved through:

- **Providing activities and programs related to the five phases of Kappa League.**
- **The development of positive relationships between Kappa League members and adult members of the fraternity.**
- **Role modeling and mentoring by adult members of the fraternity.**

PHASES

All activities and programs are related to the five phases of Kappa League. Activities include but are not limited to the following:

- ❖ PHASE I/SELF-IDENTITY-Activities include: Kappa Leaguers receive a written autobiographical assignment to be presented to their peers. Guest speakers with expertise in self esteem, self discipline, and self awareness give presentations to Kappa Leaguers.
- ❖ PHASE II/TRAINING-Activities include: tutoring, Guest speakers from various professional backgrounds discuss their career paths with Kappa Leaguers, ACT/SAT prep, resume writing/interviewing skills, money management and budgeting etc.
- ❖ PHASE III/COMPETITION-Activities include: Kappa League Officers elections, essay contest, sporting events.
- ❖ PHASE IV/SOCIAL-Activities include: Monthly church attendance, museum visits, dances, socials, field trips, “Kappa Presents”
- ❖ PHASE V/HEALTH EDUCATION-Activities include: AIDS Awareness/Prevention, Drug/Alcohol Abuse Awareness, and Physical/emotional well being.

Young men from sixth grade through twelfth are eligible.

Meetings are held usually on the first and third Sunday of the month at 3pm. Good attendance; promptness and appropriate behavior are expected. Two community service projects per year are required. KL is not a tool for recruitment for Kappa Alpha Psi. KL purpose is for leadership development. KL members are not members of Kappa Alpha Psi or Junior Kappa's.

KL Members who remain active participates in good standing are eligible for scholarships upon enrollment in college.
